Presentation Summary:

The Children's Health Foundation has been serving the Island for close to 50 years and strives to ensure that all Island kids and families have access to the health care they need.

From its beginnings as the Queen Alexandra Foundation for Children, the Foundation has instituted assistance programs and has built physical facilities to help families.

The have instituted a program of *Financial Support* for families needing health care (over \$600,000 was distributed to 646 families) as well as a *Home Away* program to house families with children in hospital and who need accommodation close by. The present homes in Victoria and Campbell River are so busy that a third residence is being planned for the Nanaimo area.

The Foundation also distributes financial support through two bursary programs, for families and students with special needs.
