Program Overview:

Eugen introduced our speaker Ann Nightingale from the Rocky Point Bird Observatory who gave a very interesting presentation on birds and migration. Did you know there are 296 varieties of birds here in Victoria? Ann talked to us about bird migration, birds do not necessarily go just North and South and the Chestnut Bank Chickadee doesn't migrate.

Ann talked about how birds are captured and banded noting that birds migrate back to the same place. They recently caught a rufus hummingbird that was caught at the same feeder 8 years later. Ann talked about the American Robin, the Northern SawWhet Owl, Thrushes, Sparrow, Warblers, Wrens and Barn Swallows to name a few.

There's a lot of new technology and Ann's presentation included watching the paths that birds take. Birds can be tracked on weather radar and by transmitters. The Swift doesn't land, they fly continuously for 10 months a year and only land to breed. Terns fly 60,000 miles a year travelling around the world.

Things that impact birds include: weather, lights, glass, pets, shrinking habitat, fewer insects.
