Program Overview:

After lunch, Carl Monk CEO of Transform International Canada (<u>Projects | Transform International Canada</u>), shared with us his incredible story: Street Business School in Burundi

Through his organization, Carl and team are bringing business skills to Burundi. They have been teaching business skills to small entrepreneurs from 2021. Like any project, it was initially hard to find participants, but now they are so successful that it is hard to keep up with the demand.

Cohorts range between 20 – 30 students. Cohort 5 and 6 are starting in May/June.

This initiative is incredibly successful. Program graduates are seeing between a 150% to 300% in the daily earning capacity. An unexpected benefit is that program graduates are creating multiple businesses and employing others in their communities. Expanding the good works of the program beyond just its participants.
